Chanukah is a Jewish holiday during the Jewish month of **Kislev**. Chanukah celebrates the defeat of the **Greeks** by the Jewish rebels. The Jewish rebels were led by **Judah Maccabee** who was also known as “the **hammer**”. When the Jewish rebels took back the Holy **Temple** in **Jerusalem**, there was only enough **oil** left for the menorah for one day, but, a **miracle** happened! That little bit of oil was enough to last eight days. Today, we celebrate this holiday by thanking G-d for His miracle. We light **candles** on each of the eight nights of Chanukah. The **shamus** (meaning servant) is the candle in the middle of the menorah (also known as the chanukiah) and is used to light all the other candles. It is also fun to eat **latkes** (potato pancakes) and play **dreidel** and win **gelt**.

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
